This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

2. The facts of the case are that the Appellant filed the Memo of Appeal on 29.04.2019 and the Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 30.04.2019, intimated the defects to the Appellant on 01.05.2019 and returned the Memo of Appeal on 02.05.2019. The Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal on 23.05.2019. It is stated in the Interlocutory Application (IA) that delay was caused due to the fact that the appeal is very voluminous in nature and due to the non-availability of the dealing clerk, finalization of the same took some time.
